Executive summary

Annually, the Trust is required to complete a self-assurance process and goes through a check-and-challenge process with Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire and Berkshire West (BOB) Integrated Care Board (ICB) to ensure compliance with the NHS England (NHSE) EPRR 'Core Standards', which reflect NHS statutory duties under the Civil Contingencies Act 2004.

The Trust's rating for 2025-26 is fully compliant with the Core Standards.

The attached documentation and subsequent evidence was scrutinised and approved by the Associate Director of Emergency Planning for BOB ICB and the Trust Emergency Planning Team.

The EPRR Annual report and results of the NHSE EPRR Core Standards Annual Assurance process for 2025/26 have also been approved at the Trust Resilience Committee held in September 2025.
